Project Recipe:

1. Stamp 4 large hearts in Poppy parade, 4 large hearts in Bubble Bath, then punch them out using the Bee Punch. Also punch out 4 additional hearts from the Basic White CS.
2. Use Poppy Parade Ink to stamp love you on one of the white hearts. Use a water painter and Poppy Parade Ink to splatter the other plain white hearts with ink. Set aside to dry.
3. Emboss a 4" X 5-1/4" piece of Crumb Cake CS using the Timber 3D embossing folder. Then attach all 12 hearts to the front using a Dimensional on the back of each.
4. Tie a piece of Sweet Sorbet and White Baker's Twine around the CS and make a bow. Attach this layer to a Thick Basic White card base. Embellish with white sequins.
