- Whisper White 8-1/2" X 11" Thick Cardstock [140272] \$11.25
- Early Espresso 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [119686] \$13.75
- Basic White 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [159276] \$14.50
- A Little Latte 12" X 12" (30.5 X 30.5 Cm) Designer Series Paper [163453] \$17.00
- Latte Love Bundle (English) [163461] \$64.75
- Early Espresso Classic Stampin' Pad [147114] \$12.25
- Pecan Pie Classic Stampin' Pad [161665] \$12.25
- Lost Lagoon Classic Stampin' Pad [161678] \$12.25
- Flirty Flamingo Stampin' Blends Combo Pack [154884] \$13.75

Project Recipe:

1. Stamp sentiment in top left corner of a 3-7/8" X 5-1/8" piece of basic White CS using Lost Lagoon Ink. Then add two splatter images using pecan Pie Ink.
2. Near the center right of the same CS stamp first and 2nd generation coffee ring images using Pecan Pie ink.
3. Use the stitched curve from Basic Border dies to cut a piece of 1-1/2" X 3-7/8" DSP. Adhere to the stamped layer, then adhere to a 4" X 5-1/4" Early Espresso CS layer and onto the Thick Basic White card base.
4. Stamp 2 mugs using Early Espresso Ink. Add the coffee inside using Pecan Pie Ink. Then colour the mugs with Stampin' Blends. I used Flirty Flamingo and Daffodil Delight. Attach the mugs to the card front using Dimensionals.
5. Embellish with Swirl Dots.
