## May 29 - Layout #2



### Supplies needed:

- Crumb Cake 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [120953]
- Pecan Pie 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [161717]
- Basic Black 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [121045]
- Basic Beige 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [164511]
- Basic White 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [159276]
- Legendary Ride Cling Stamp Set (English) [160754]
- Adhesive Backed Textured Dots [163338]
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue [110755]
- Stampin' Dimensionals [104430]
- Basic White Medium Envelopes [159236]
- Mini Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine [150673]
- Pecan Pie Classic Stampin' Pad [161665]
- Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad [132708]
- Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker [162481]
- Something Fancy Dies [160424]
- Metal Plate 3 D Embossing Folder [160766]

### Project Recipe:

1. Adhere 3 Basic White strips (1" X 4-1/2", embossed with Metal Plate 3D EF) to the 3 Pecan Pie cardstock strips (1-1/8" X 4-5/8"). Then adhere these strips to the Crumb cake card base (5-1/2" X 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"). Adhere the 4" X 5-1/4" Basic White CS to the inside of the card.
2. Use Pecan Pie Ink to stamp the small motorcycle on the 2-1/2" X 3-1/2" piece of Basic Beige CS. Then use the Basic Black Marker to draw a double line around the edge of the Basic Beige CS. Adhere to card front using Dimensionals.
3. Stamp sentiment using Memento Black Ink on a piece of Basic White cardstock that has been die cut with the smaller Something Fancy label die. Use the Basic Black marker to draw a single line border around the label - you can follow the very slight embossed line that is there. Attach to card front using Dimensionals. Then embellish with 2 larger Textured Dots on either side of the label.
