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Winter Meadow Gift Card Holder



Supplies needed:

- Winter Meadow 12" X 12" (30.5 X 30.5 Cm) Designer Series Paper [162133] \$17.00
- Basic White 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [159276] \$18.00
- Christmas Labels Bundle (English) [164101] \$64.75

- Blueberry Bushel Classic Stampin' Pad [147138] \$12.25
- 1-3/4" (4.4 Cm) Circle Punch [119850] \$32.00
- Nested Essentials Dies [161597] \$47.00
- Paper Trimmer [152392] \$39.00
- Tear & Tape Adhesive [138995] \$9.50
- Stampin' Dimensionals [104430] \$6.00

Project Recipe:

1. Using a 4" X 11" piece of DSP that has a non-directional pattern, score the DSP at 2", 5", and 8-1/8".
2. Use the 1-3/4" circle punch to cut a 1/2 circle into the smallest end of the DSP. Then cut a piece of Tear'n' Tape in half length wise and use it to glue down the two edges of the short flap. Creating a pocket.
3. Next feed the other end of the DSP into the largest Nested Essentials hexagon so roll through the Stampin' Cut and Emboss machine until the V has been cut. Roll it back out the other way so you don't get lines on our DSP.
4. Cut a Nested Essentials rounded rectangle from Basic White CS and glue on the inside panel just above the pocket panel.
5. Fold the gift card holder closed. Take a 1" X 7" strip of DSP or cardstock. Wrap it around the gift card holder and use Tear'n' Tape to secure the two ends together.
6. Use the Christmas Label dies to cut a label from basic White CS. Then use Blueberry Bushel Ink to stamp the coordinating sentiment of your choice from the Christmas Labels stamp set. Adhere the label using a Dimensionals to cover where your belly band is glued together.
