- Softly Woven 3D Embossing Folder [168466] [168466]

Project Recipe:

1. Emboss a 4" X 5-1/4" piece of Lost Lagoon cardstock with a the Softly Woven 3D Embossing Folder. Adhere with liquid glue to the lost Lagoon cardbase (5-1/2" X 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4").
2. Cut a 2-3/4" X 4" piece of Cherry Cobbler striped " A Little Christmas" DSP. Adhere it with liquid glue to a 2-7/8" X 4-1/8" piece of Cherry Cobbler cardstock. Then adhere to the center of the cardfront.
3. Fussy cut the mice climbing into the jar of cookies from another sheet of "A Little Christmas" DSP and attach it to a Vellum circle (diecut with the largest Stylish Shapes circle) using Dimensionals. Adhere these pieces to the card front using Liquid Glue hidden behind the DSP image.
4. On a 3/4" X 3-1/2" piece of Cheery Cobbler cardstock, heat emboss the sentiment using white embossing powder. Trim the ends on a diagonal and adhere below the circle image using Dimensionals.
5. Tie a bow using Crumb Cake Baker's Twine and attach to the cardfront with a dab of Liquid Glue. Embellish the card front with 3 Adhesive-backed Gold Dots.
6. If desired, layer a piece of basic White ardstock inside and decorate with a few fussy cut gingerbread cookies.
